For when:

- A serious crime is happening or was just committed
- Life or serious injury is threatened
- An immediate threat to people or property exists

For reporting:

- A disturbance or antisocial behaviour
- Something which has happened in the past
- A property-related incident for insurance purposes

- Report any non-urgent information about criminal activity or suspicious behaviour
- Information can be current or from the past
